

2023 Official Rules

NoCo Grocery Grab Rules

Each raffle winner will select two individuals to participate in the shopping experience on April 2, 2023, at Lucky's Market in Fort Collins, CO. The winner can be one of the participants or may select two other participants who are at least 14 years of age.

Partners reserves the right to make any changes to the event based on any public health concerns. In the event of illness, winners may select two other participants or may receive a gift card in lieu of participation in the event.

All alcohol, tobacco, medicinal, and apothecary items are prohibited to be purchased or obtained with the raffle winnings.

Some item quantities may be limited during the shopping experience. All ticket holders must be 18 years of age.

Raffle tickets and items purchased during the shopping event do not have a cash value and cannot be returned for cash or credit. Larimer County Partners and all other contractors do not guarantee the quality of products purchased during the shopping events.

Ticket sales are nonrefundable.

Charity Raffle License

The NoCo Grocery Grab Raffle is presented by Larimer County Partners, Inc. Board of Directors, a Colorado nonprofit organization exempt from taxation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, located at 530 S. College Ave. Unit 1, Fort Collins, CO 80524, to raise funds for its ongoing charitable activities and purposes.

The NoCo Grocery Grab Raffle is licensed by the Colorado Secretary of State Bingo-Raffles Division under Raffle License No. 2023-18102. The Raffle is subject to the rules set forth below ("Rules"), as well as the laws of the State of Colorado, and the rules, regulations and statutes set out in the Colorado Constitution, Article XVIII, Section 2, C.R.S. Title 12, Article 9 and the Code of Colorado Regulations – Rules Covering and Regulating Bingo and Raffle Games (8 CCR 1505-2) (such Colorado laws, rules, regulations and statutes are sometimes collectively referred to as "Applicable Law"). A copy of the rules, regulations and statutes, as well as the license issued to Larimer County Partners, Inc. Board of Directors, is available for inspection from Larimer County Partners, Inc. Board of Directors. If there is a conflict between these Rules and Applicable Law, Larimer County Partners, Inc. Board of Directors will consult with the Secretary of State's office, and, in the event that the dispute is deemed outside of the Colorado Secretary of State's jurisdiction, an outside arbitrator will be consulted.

Larimer County Partners, Inc. Board of Directors reserves the right to modify the rules as may be necessary or required to comply with Applicable Law. The purchaser and holder of each ticket agrees that, by purchasing and/or holding the ticket, they agree and consent to the Rules and Larimer County Partners, Inc. Board of Directors' interpretation and application of these Rules.

The Rules and protectable elements of the Raffle are copyrighted (or protected by other applicable intellectual property rights) materials of Larimer County Partners, Inc. Board of Directors and may not be copied, reproduced, distributed, or used in whole or part in any manner without the express written consent of Larimer County Partners, Inc. Board of Directors All rights are hereby reserved.

Purchaser and Holder Eligibility

Ticket purchasers and holders must be at least 18 years of age and reside in the United States. A ticket may not be purchased or held by (1) an individual who is prohibited from purchasing or holding a ticket under Applicable Law or applicable U.S. federal law or (2) the following individuals and members of their immediate family who reside at the same address: (a) Larimer County Partners, Inc. employees, (b) members of the Larimer County Partners, Inc. Board of directors. A ticket may not be transferred. Persons who reside outside the United States may not purchase tickets.

Only tickets that have been paid for and/or have been verified as paid for are eligible to be entered for the respective draws. By purchasing a ticket, prize winners consent to the use of their names by Larimer County Partners, Inc. Board of Directors for publication purposes. Raffle is void where prohibited by law.

Larimer County Partners, Inc. Board of Directors reserves the right to require reasonable evidence documenting each ticket purchaser and holder's eligibility to purchase and/or hold a ticket. Larimer County Partners, Inc. Board of Directors also reserves the right to void any ticket sold to or held by an individual who is not eligible to purchase and/or hold a ticket under these Rules.

Raffle Ticket Information

Tickets will be issued in the name of one (1) holder only. All tickets in a ticket pack will contain identical purchaser information. Tickets will be issued in the name of an individual person (i.e. first name, last name). An eligible purchaser may designate another person as the ticket holder. No groups, corporate entities, or other entities may be named on a ticket. If more than one holder is named on a ticket, the first name listed will be treated as the holder for all purposes, and Larimer County Partners, Inc. Board of Directors shall not have any obligation with respect to the other individuals named on the ticket.

The odds of winning will depend on the number of tickets sold.

Tickets may be purchased online at <https://nocogrocerygrab.rallyup.com/nocogrocerygrab>. Ticket purchases may be made only by valid major credit cards; cash and check are not accepted.

Tickets will be issued and assigned ticket numbers in the order in which purchased tickets are processed. Official tickets will be issued by email only and will not be sent by U.S. Mail. It is the right of Larimer County Partners, Inc. Board of Directors to disallow any ticket orders that do not meet the criteria set out in the Rules or in accordance with Applicable Law. Ticket refunds will not be issued after a ticket has been purchased. Changes or refunds to tickets will not be allowed after a ticket has been purchased unless a ticket is sold after the final ticket sales deadline. Larimer County Partners, Inc. Board of Directors is not responsible for any failure to receive orders or deliver official tickets prior to the final ticket sales deadline. Holders are not required to have received their official tickets in order to be included in the draws.

Ticket Deadlines

Final ticket sales deadline: midnight, March 26, 2023.

Drawing Information

The Final Deadline for ticket sales is midnight Mountain Daylight Time, March 26, 2023. The drawing for prizes will begin on March 27, 2023, at 11:00 AM, Mountain Daylight Time. The drawing will take place at 530 S. College Ave. Unit 1, Fort Collins, CO 80524 and on our Facebook Live. Winners are NOT required to attend in person or virtually to be eligible to win.

The Games Manager will conduct all prize draws. All prizes will be drawn randomly in a manner licensed by the Colorado Secretary of State. All prize draws are open to the public. Purchasers are not required to be present during any draws in order to win prizes. Winning tickets for all draws will not be reentered for any remaining draws and therefore a ticket purchaser or holder cannot possibly win more than one prize.

Larimer County Partners, Inc. Board of Directors with the approval of the Colorado Secretary of State in accordance to Applicable Law, may postpone, alter or cancel a drawing.

Prize Information

A total of three prizes, as described on NoCoGroceryGrab.com, will be awarded, with a total value of \$2,250. Prizes may not be awarded exactly as illustrated in promotional materials due to circumstances outside the reasonable control of Larimer County Partners, Inc. Board of Directors or its third-party prize providers but will be of equivalent quality and value.

Prize Claim

All prizes must be accepted as awarded unless otherwise stated in the Rules or as deemed necessary by Larimer County Partners, Inc. Board of Directors and upon approval of the Colorado Secretary of State. All prize winners must be eligible holders under the Rules and Applicable Law. If a prize winner is found not to comply with the Rules or Applicable Law, then the corresponding prize may be forfeited and retained by Larimer County Partners, Inc. Board of Directors

Each prize will be awarded to the individual named on the winning ticket. Initial prize notification letters will be promptly sent to all prize winners by U.S. Mail or by email to the address shown in the Raffle database, as provided by the purchaser. Prize draw results will be posted at NoCoGroceryGrab.com within 24 hours of each draw. If a winner, has not responded by the date of the shopping event they will receive a gift card to Lucky's Market for their prize amount.

Tax Information

Raffle ticket purchases are not tax-deductible for income tax purposes. However, a winner may deduct the cost of a winning ticket from the value of the prize awarded in determining the amount to include in taxable gross income with respect to the prize. Winners should consult a tax advisor for guidance.

Raffle prize winnings are considered income and are generally subject to federal and state income taxes and may be subject to state and local sales or use taxes.

Final Records

In the event of a dispute regarding ticket information, the official records of Larimer County Partners, Inc. Board of Directors held in the Raffle database shall be deemed correct and final.

Privacy Commitment

Larimer County Partners, Inc. Board of Directors respects your privacy. Larimer County Partners, Inc. Board of Directors will use personal information provided by you to fulfill raffle ticket orders, provide information on our future raffles, contact prize winners and publicize the names of prize winners online. We do not rent, sell or trade our contact lists or purchasers list, but we may solicit charitable donations from raffle buyers. Limitation of Liability

Ticket purchasers and holders expressly acknowledge that they release Larimer County Partners, Inc. Board of Directors, Larimer County Partners, Inc. Board of Directors officers, employees, agents or representatives or others in any related companies, affiliates of otherwise connected entities from all forms of liability with respect to the Raffle, including, but not limited to, any injuries, losses or damages of any kind arising in connection with the Raffle and/or a person's failure to win a prize or a person's award, acceptance or use of any prize. Each ticket purchaser and holder also represents and warrants that he or she has read and understands these Rules and agrees to be bound by these Rules and Larimer County Partners, Inc. Board of Directors' decisions, which it will accept as final. As a condition to receipt of any prize, the holder of a winning ticket agrees to sign and deliver to Larimer County Partners, Inc. Board of Directors if requested by Larimer County Partners, Inc. Board of Directors in its sole and absolute discretion, a written release and prize claim form provided and drafted by Larimer County Partners, Inc. Board of Directors that includes, but is not limited to, his or her Social Security number, proof that the purchaser was an eligible purchaser and the holder an eligible holder, an affidavit regarding compliance with the Rules and a publicity release, all as determined necessary in the sole and absolute discretion of Larimer County Partners, Inc. Board of Directors.

A TICKET PURCHASER'S OR HOLDER'S SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE REMEDY FOR Larimer County Partners, Inc. Board of Directors BREACH SHALL BE LIMITED TO THE RETURN OF THE PURCHASE PRICE PAID FOR HIS OR HER RAFFLE TICKET(S).

Arbitration

In the event of any dispute regarding the conduct of this Raffle or the award of prizes thereunder, Larimer County Partners, Inc. Board of Directors and all ticket purchasers and holders agree that the question in dispute shall be submitted and consult with the Secretary of State's office, and, in the event that the dispute is deemed outside of their jurisdiction, then the dispute can be further taken to an outside arbitrator in Fort Collins, Colorado. The single arbitrator shall be an experienced commercial arbitrator selected as follows: (1) upon declaration by one of the parties hereto that a deadlock exists, the parties shall mutually select a single arbitrator; (2) if no appointment is made within 30 days after

the deadlock is declared and the amount in contest is in excess of \$200, the arbitrator shall be selected in accordance with the Commercial Arbitration Rules and Mediation Procedures of the American Arbitration Association; or (3) if no appointment is made within 30 days after the deadlock is declared and the amount in question is \$200 or less, Larimer County Partners, Inc. Board of Directors shall select an independent third party to be the single arbitrator. The single arbitrator will submit a decision within 30 days after appointment or as soon as reasonably feasible and such decision shall be binding on the parties hereto. Arbitration expenses, including the fees of the arbitrator, cost of any record or transcript of the arbitration, administrative fees and other fees and costs will be borne equally by the parties. All other expenses (legal, incidental, etc.) shall be borne by the losing party or, if both parties prevail, be apportioned by the arbitrator to each party. Arbitration proceedings will be governed by the Commercial Arbitration Rules and Mediation Procedures of the American Arbitration Association then in effect.
