

Why you should Make the Call

- Nearly 17% of teens surveyed admitted to driving in a car while a driver who had been drinking.
- Studies have shown that, of seriously injured drivers admitted to trauma centers, more than 1 out of 4 tested positive for marijuana.
- In 2019, 24% of young drivers ages 15-20 who died in car crashes had blood alcohol concentrations of .01 or higher.
